Japanese company Rauh-Welt Begriff (RWB) brought two impressive vehicle to the 2011 SEMA Auto Show. The first was a Porsche 911 RWB Pandora One and the second is this impressive 911 Turbo Hoonigan - a model based on a Porsche 964. The 911 Turbo Hoonigan combines a white exterior paint job with a Lobster Red interior and red Fifteen52 wheels wearing Pirelli P Zero tires. The car's ride was also lowered by an inch and a half thanks to a new sports suspension system. The Porsche 964 presented at the show is currently owned by former O-60 Magazine editor-in-chief, Brian Scotto. He drove the car for over 850 miles just to get to the 2011 SEMA Auto Show in time, where it celebrated the launch of the Ken Block's new Hoonigan brand. With a maiden vehicle like this Porsche and Ken Block's involvement, we expect to hear the name "Hoonigan" a lot in the upcoming months.[...]
