The Mine's 370Z, for the first time, comes with dry carbon parts including a front lip spoiler, rear wing, antenna cover and front Air Scoop Type-IIs integrated in the front bumper.

Power has been upgraded through a Mine's VX-ROM ECU, Mine's VX-AIR Filter, a Mine's Silence-VX PRO Titan II Titanium Exhaust and engine oil cooler. The Z rests on 20-inch Rays Volk Racing TE37 Generation2 (G3) with Cusco Type-RS coilovers. The Z interior comes with the Takata MPH-340R safety belts and Recaro SP-G seats.
