

Chevrolet Corvette C7 Stingray By GeigerCars

It's no secret the Corvette C7 Stingray is a hot performer. With its 460 horsepower and 465 pound-feet of torque, the C7 launches itself to 60 mph in a very respectable 3.9 seconds. Its handling is spectacular too, thanks in part to the Magnetic Ride Control shocks and other Z51-specific parts. However, improvements can always be made. That's where one tuner company based in Germany steps in. *GeigerCars* has developed a performance upgrade kit that includes new coil-over shocks, a carbon-fiber body kit, and an Eaton supercharger. That last bit helps the Stingray's 6.2-liter V-8 produce an extra 128 horsepower and 107 pound-feet of torque. Now pushing out 582 horses and 558 pound-feet, the Vette's trap time should be noticeably quicker. In fact, *GeigerCars* claims the Vette's new top speed is 198 mph. That's a big improvement over the stock Stingray's 178-mph top speed.[...]
