The seats are yet to be changed and so is the steering wheel, otherwise beige leather with red trimming would make absolutely no sense!

The body and engine however, are fully done! ASMA has literally facelifted the Continental. It wears a wide body kit with redesigned bumpers and flaps and everything, all finished in glossy piano black. And with the blacked-out grille and 22-inch black wheels, the Venustus is a showcase of ASMA's dark side! The new aero parts like the spoiler lips or the rear diffuser are made of carbon fiber.

As for the engine, well there is enough power in there to start a sand storm in the desert! 644 hp and 780 nm of torque is at the disposal of Sheikh's right foot which let him accelerate non-stop right up to the exciting horizons of 325 km/h!
